Over the last century, Hilton has profoundly and positively transformed landscapes, economies, countries, and travel experiences across the globe – creating new opportunities for millions of people through employment, ownership, and investment in communities.

Hilton is one of the world's largest hospitality companies, with more than 5,600 properties, comprising nearly 913,000 rooms in 113 countries and territories. Hilton is committed to being everywhere guests want to travel. In 2018, Hilton:

- Opened more than one hotel per day, expanding to 113 countries and territories
- Grew development pipeline to 364,000 rooms across 15 brands, supported by almost 110,000 new rooms approved in 60 countries and territories, with construction starts on 83,000 rooms totaling 184,000 rooms under construction
- Achieved almost seven percent net unit growth, opened more than a hotel per day, adding more than 450 properties to surpass 5,600 properties globally with nearly 913,000 rooms in 113 countries and territories
- Extended Hilton's signature hospitality to 166 million guests around the world
- Opened 1,000th [All Suites Brands by Hilton](#) property with the Homewood Suites by Hilton in Pleasant Hill, California; [Curio Collection by Hilton](#) surpassed 65 hotels opened; and [Tru by Hilton](#) continued its rapid growth reaching 50 open hotels and celebrated at the Tru by Hilton Salt Lake City Airport
- Opened first [tri-branded Hilton property](#) in Chicago at McCormick Place featuring Hilton Garden Inn, Hampton Inn and Home2 Suites

Hilton continues to invest in development globally, with one of the fastest growing development pipeline in the industry.

- Hilton's development pipeline includes projects expected to open by 2020 in 20+ new countries around the world.
- There are 2,400+ hotels in Hilton's development pipeline, with more than half located outside the U.S.
- In Q4 2018, Hilton approved 24,900 new rooms for development, growing Hilton's development pipeline to more than 364,000 rooms as of December 31, 2018, representing 6 percent growth from December 31, 2017.
- Hilton opened 22,500 rooms in the fourth quarter, contributing to 57,000 net additional rooms for the full year, which represented approximately 7 percent net unit growth.
